You must be 18 years or older at the time of the trip.

Payment Schedule

- Deposit of \$2,774 is due at the time of registration and is non-refundable before June 8, 2025 for early bird registrars
- Deposit of \$2,974 is due at the time of registration and is non-refundable after June 9, 2025
- Second payment \$2,773 is due by August 11, 2025 if you signed up before August 9, 2025 for early bird registrars
- Second payment of \$2,973 is due by August 11, 2025 if you signed up after August 9, 2025

If payment is not received by the due date, Sew & Sew Retreats is entitled to give written notice that your guest retreat reservation is cancelled. You, the guest, will remain liable to pay the balance of the reservation unless we are able to sell the retreat space.

Your place on the *Celebrate Hawaiian Textiles* retreat will be confirmed once receiving the non-refundable deposit of the total amount due. Payment may be made by credit or debit card or PayPal. Be aware that PayPal charges the highest fees, so a credit/debit card is best.

Cancellation

There are no refunds in the event of a guest cancellation. No refunds of any for any reason on any amount paid. The deposit is not refundable and there is no refund after the balance has been paid. Guests are strongly encouraged to arrange travel insurance including cancellation coverage, plus coverage for personal belongings, public liability, medical, etc. (This is why you should get travel insurance. See below.) When purchasing insurance, you can use the start date for coverage as the day you paid the deposit.

In the event you need to cancel, you may find a friend to take your place for the retreat. Also, if we have a wait list, we can contact people on that list to replace your spot. Please contact me as soon as possible to see if we can transfer your spot to someone else.

In the event that Sew & Sew Retreats determines the retreat needs to be cancelled, you will receive a refund of your deposit. That refund should be received within 30 days of the announcement of the cancellation by Sew & Sew Retreats.

Travel Insurance

Get it! Well, it is strongly encouraged for you to get it. Think of it as a vital part of your travel arrangements. Insurance protects you, your trip, and your travel investment. When purchasing insurance, you can **use the start date for coverage as the day you paid the deposit**.

Travel suppliers, airline carriers, and Sew & Sew Retreats or Linda Sweek will not compensate any unforeseen expenses in the event of cancellation or failure to make your trip, missed flights, lost baggage, loss of health, death and/or accidents or emergency evacuation due to illness, natural disasters or acts of terrorism. Also, it is strongly recommended that you purchase a travel insurance policy for the duration of the journey, not just airfare.

It is strongly recommended you and your party arrange comprehensive travel insurance, which includes cancellation, repatriation, medical and personal cover and also full cover for the party's personal belongings.

Should you decide not to purchase travel insurance, you assume sole financial liability for all direct and indirect consequences and costs resulting from events occurring before or during the trip.

You do not have the right to demand compensation from Sew & Sew Retreats or Linda Sweek, or retreat teachers for any unforeseen expenses incurred as a direct result of cancellation or failure to make your trip, lost baggage, loss of health, death, accidents and/or emergency evacuation due to natural disasters or acts of terrorism.

- **Health Insurance:** Medical facilities and providers may require cash up front and may not accept U.S. insurance plans. Check your health care policy to see if it will cover you in other states. If not, consider buying <u>supplemental insurance</u>. Make sure the insurance you purchase covers any special medical needs or risks you anticipate on your trip.
- **Emergency Medical Evacuation:** Evacuation for medical treatment can cost more than \$100,000. You should strongly consider purchasing <u>medical evacuation insurance</u> in case of emergency overseas."

As part of the Registration process, you need to ACCEPT or DECLINE that you will or will not purchase travel insurance.

Credit or Debit Cards & Cash

Make sure you contact your bank or credit/debit card company to inform them of your travel to Hawaii along with the dates of the trip. Otherwise, purchases may look suspicious and be alerted for fraud.
